

**UNITARIAN UNIVERSALIST FELLOWSHIP OF LOS GATOS**  
**SPECIAL CONGREGATIONAL BUSINESS MEETING**  
**February 26, 2006**

Meeting was called to order at 12:20PM.

President Walter Main presided.

There were 29 voting members present.  
Quorum is 20% of 97 total members = 20.

Rev. Nancy Roemheld opened the meeting with a reading, and then left.

Linda Krenicky reported that Rev. Nancy wishes to return to join her family at the end of her current contract rather than continue for a second year as our Interim Minister.

At Rev. Nancy's request, Linda read an excerpt from an article entitled "Special Care Congregations: The necessities of two year interims". Copies had been distributed to all attendees before the start of the meeting.

After a brief discussion of the article, Walt presented the recommendation of the Fellowship leadership as follows:

That we search for a settled minister, targeting to find and call one in the spring of 2007, to arrive in the summer of 2007.

That we search for and contract with an interim minister for the 2006-2007 year.

After a full discussion of these recommendations, Bill Scarvie moved, and it was seconded, that the Leadership Recommendations be accepted. The motion was passed with 22 voting "yea" and 4 "nay".

Those interested in serving on the Interim Minister Search Committee were asked to contact the Nominating Committee. A mail ballot is planned containing the names of all interested as well as the names of those selected by the Nominating Committee.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:12PM.
