*Rev. Sonya Sukalski is the Consulting Minister for the Unitarian Universalist Legislative Ministry of California's Young Leaders Project. She is developing a curriculum for the Spiritual Activist Leadership Training (SALT), a nine month non-resident program for young adults aged 18-35 interested in leading social justice programs and actions. Designed with UU values in mind, it will include 2-3 retreats, monthly theological reflection circles, various "justice plunges," periodic web-based training, and an attention to spiritual direction and practice. Called "Salt Fellows," each participant will be mentored and choose a justice issue for both group and individual projects.*
