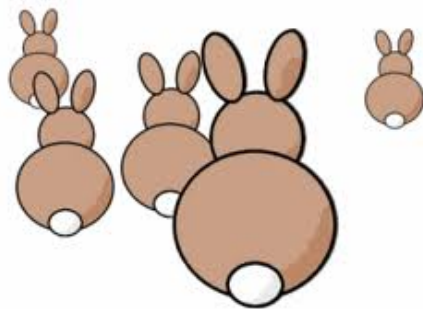

***The Dustbunnies Present ...  
the Ole Time Good Spell Feri Pagan Tent Revival***

Being that the Feri Tent Revival calls upon the Gods and Guardians of our Tradition in our service, and being that some of those Names aren't heard much outside our circles, we thought y'all might like to know who it is that we are calling to, and why.

In our Tradition, we believe that all things are Holy, all ideas and underpinnings and quarks and complex organisms are Holy. We believe that where we stand is Holy, that we are the Center of the Universe (and so are you, and you, and you...) and we are also the Circumference of All. And we are fond of Poetic Truth, as you may have guessed.

From our place in the Center, we look out onto a World of our making and draw upon our Allies to help us in the Work of becoming more effective, more joyous and more creative Humans.

The Allies guide and guard us in our rites,  
and lend us their unique energies.

Some of the Powers we invite are:

- Starfinder: Power of the East, of Air
- Shining Flame: Power of the South, of Fire

- WaterMaker: Power of the West, of Water
- Black Mother: Power of the North, of Earth
  - Heaven Shiner: Power Above, Expansion
  - Fire in the Earth: Power Below, Depth
- Guardian at the Gate: Power Within, The Center which is the Circumference of All

In our Tradition, we say that “there is no part of Us that is not of the Gods.” This means that we honor and celebrate all parts of ourselves: the physical and metaphysical; and all parts of our lives, from birth to death and back again. All things expand and contract, rise and fall, in their time, us included, and so we honor Gods of each age and every Power.

The ones we will call on today are:

- Nimue: Maiden Goddess, fierce and inscrutable
- Dian y Glas: Young Blue God, beautiful beyond measure
  - Mari: Our Gracious Mother, Nurturer and Lover
  - Krom: Father of us All, at the height of His Strength
  - The Ana: Mysterious Crone, our Final Refuge
- The Arddhu: Black Father, Teacher of Ancient Wisdom

*Victor and Cora Anderson are the Mother and Father of Feri WitchCraft, the GrandMasters of the Tradition. Poetry, Physics, Cooking, Herbalism, Biology, Music, Astral Travel; these were some of the Magicks they practiced and taught in their over 40 years of Work in the Craft. Victor went on to the next world in 2001 and Cora in 2008. They are still very much honored and sorely missed.*

*Dustbunnies is the name of our working group, because we are ubiquitous and mysterious (Where do they come from? They're everywhere!)*

*Feri (or Fairy or Faery) is the name of our WitchCraft Tradition. There are many ideas about why Victor gave us this designation, but no one right answer. We are an 'occult' Tradition, not a revealed religion, after all.*

*We are fond of Enigma.*

*In the Feri Tradition, we honor the Divine as immanent and many natured.  
We seek self- knowledge, self-healing and self-possession, and our deep  
Work enables and encourages us to walk proudly and with the highest
